**2018 SUMMER SCHOOL SCHEDULE:** Monday through Thursday 8:30 A.M. – 2:30 P.M.

**SESSION I: JUNE 11 – JUNE 28 (3 weeks)**

**SESSION II: JULY 2 – JULY 19 (3 weeks)**

**MPHS is CLOSED from MAY 21<sup>st</sup> to June 11th and the month of August. Satellite resumes the second week in September.**

**MPHS Flexible Scheduling:** MPHS is highly specialized in individual and small group instruction on an on-going basis. The school specializes in facilitating and supporting self-paced learning in a structured environment. Therefore, as an added benefit, our Summer School can provide flexibility for summer vacation schedules, camps, mission trips and sports activities. Please list in advance of any summer plans when registering. Courses at MPHS are not online; each has a dedicated teacher and Course Guide.

**The traditional Summer School is a structured classroom format that begins on June 11<sup>th</sup> Monday through Thursdays.** Each session includes 3 weeks of classroom instruction for each course, A and B. The course is self-paced and students can work ahead if they are able to, or receive extra help as needed. Students can also start their work early independently at home if they have the time and ability. If a registered Summer School student would like to start their course *prior to* June 11<sup>th</sup> and wants/needs to come in for help and take the Mastery Quizzes, there is a \$35 per session fee. Enrolling in Summer School indicates that the student is scheduled to complete the course by July 19, allows enough time for grade transfer to the home school for Fall scheduling and classification. If, for a qualified reason, an enrolled Summer School student does not complete their course, they may arrange Fall tutoring appointments with MPHS at \$35 per session to help complete the course.

**Satellite School is by appointment for the student that cannot attend the Summer School classroom.** This “by appointment” option allows the student to take the course with one-to-one and small group teaching. The student is expected to complete what would have been classroom work, independently at home. Students are allotted 8 hours/appointments, which is essentially an hour appointment per Lesson (there are eight Lessons in each semester). The appointment also includes time for listening and speaking for foreign language, questions and review, and taking the Mastery Quiz. **Satellite course deadlines are four months from the time each course is started** (not necessarily registered). **Seniors have April 15<sup>th</sup> as a deadline during the Spring semester, and work not completed by April 15<sup>th</sup> will be logged on the transcript as an Incomplete.**

**Satellite student appointment hours during the Summer-time: Mon – Thurs, between 12:30pm-2:30pm.**

**Fall and Spring Satellite students appointment hours: Mon – Thurs afternoons between 4:30pm-7:00pm.**

**What the Spanish course encompasses:** Courses are not online. Students are given a Course Guide (most all of the semester’s assignments). MPHS is on the Mastery System which means that students will have to complete a Mastery Quiz after each Lesson. This means that some students may be able to absorb the information more quickly and finish early. Likewise, students that need more than the allotted time may use our afternoon tutoring labs for an additional fee.

**PRICING: Each Summer School or Satellite course - semester A or semester B is \$490. Summer or Satellite School is \$980.00 for both semesters.** Texas requires that both semesters are taken in order to count (such as Spanish). Textbooks are provided and the fee is included; textbooks must be returned upon the completion of the course.

**Summer and Satellite School students are required by Memorial Private High School to obtain the signature of their home school counselor to insure proper communication and transfer of the course credit(s).**

Refund policy: If for any reason, a student is unable to start a course, a refund will be given minus a \$75 admin fee per course.
